JUNE BEVAN CARNIVAL

Taranaki Badminton Association is proud to be sending two competitors to the June Bevan Carnival in Melbourne. Pun Thepkunhanimit (pictured right) and Danny Nicholls are both talented young players with a promising career ahead of them in Badminton.

The festival will be held at Western Suburbs Badminton Association in Melbourne from the 29th of March to the 6th of April.

The Under 17 Australasian Championships is the largest age group tournament on the BA junior calendar. In 2005, 17 State/Territory and regional teams competed for the coveted



June Bevan Trophy – the team's component of the competition. The format is a team's competition followed by an individual championship. Under 17 teams from Oceania and BWF member countries are invited to this Australasian Championships and in 2005, apart from the regular participation by three New Zealand regional teams, a combined Oceania team entered for the first time with players from Samoa and Fiji.

Originally conceived as a preparation arena for Under 18 'Carnival' competitions, the 1979 proposal from Victoria for an Under 16 interstate carnival aimed to introduce promising juniors to a carnival atmosphere and help them develop the skills and confidence to compete in elite events.

The Nationals holds a warm and sentimental place in the memories of all those who have been involved in or have contributed to its success. The record of achievement of many players who began their badminton careers as an Under 16/17 team member is an inspiration and incentive to many more young badminton juniors in the future.
